The story of Thanksgiving is basically the story of the Pilgrims and their thankful community feast at Plymouth, Massachusetts. The Pilgrims, who 1. _____ from Plymouth, England on a ship called the Mayflower on 6 September, 1620, were the fortune hunters, bound for the resourceful 'New World'. The Mayflower was a small ship 2. _____ men, women and children, besides the 3. _____ on board. After land was sighted in November following 66 days of a lethal voyage , a meeting 4. _____ and an agreement of truce was worked out. It was called the Mayflower Compact.
