#### Beginnings:


- ➤ Derived from British traditions

### Christmas Traditions

- Leaving out some cakes and drinks for Santa
- Church services on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day
- Not opening their presents on Christmas Eve, only the next day (Boxing Day)
